## PROGRAMS

### Neighborhood Watch Program

The Neighborhood Watch Program is a free crime prevention program designed to prevent crime and reduce fear. Members of

the Neighborhood Watch Program serve as extra eyes and ears for the police department. Members learn how to make their homes more secure, and learn how to report suspicious activity to the police. This is a great way to get to know your neighbors, also a great way to meet different members of the police department.

### Business Watch Program

The Business Watch Program is a free program designed to give local merchants the skills to safeguard their businesses and employees against crime. The Business Watch Program provides information on how to report crime, business security, and shoplifting & check fraud prevention.

### Civilian Ride Along Program

The Ride Along Program allows interested citizens to "ride along" with a beat officer during a regular patrol shift. This is a free program. Participants must sign a liability waiver and are subject to a computerized records check.

### Volunteer Program

The Volunteer Program is designed for citizens who are interested in volunteering in the department. There are many different volunteer opportunities within the department including police facility tour guide, neighborhood watch assistant and many more.
