The Opportunity & Ideal Candidate:

The City of San Gabriel's Public Works Department is seeking a self-motivated individual to fill a Maintenance Lead position. The ideal candidate will have experience working safely and efficiently under hazardous traffic conditions; perform maintenance and repairs to city streets and sewer systems; and communicate well with city staff and leadership. Maintenance Leads participate in and assign to others a variety of projects to meet department goals, ensure positive working relationships with others, and must be able to hold themselves and others accountable for their work, so strong leadership skills are required. If you are someone with these qualities and who enjoys working in a team environment, then we would like to hear from you!

Due to small staff size, sometimes it may be necessary to assist other divisions in the department. Availability for emergency callback and weekend standby are required.

Position Summary:

Under general supervision of the Field Operations Manager, the Sewer Maintenance Leadperson oversees and assists an assigned crew with a variety of work in the maintenance, improvement, and operation of the City's gravity sewer lines and pumping station; ensures effective organizing and planning skills and optimizes resources to ensure highly productive crews for efficiency and proper care and use of tools and equipment; assists in maintaining records of time, equipment and materials used and assists with training and evaluation of staff; performs other related duties as assigned.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Coordinates crew assignments, tools, equipment and materials for assigned jobs such as sewer line flushing and cleaning, rodding, pipeline repair and replacement, and pump station maintenance.
- Ensures proper safety precautions are followed at the work site including traffic control devices and personal protective equipment.
- Leads emergency callout response, including crew dispatch for sanitary sewer overflow mitigation, spill documentation, and restoration management coordination of residual backup.
- Records daily crew work activities using CityWorks activity tracking software in the field.
- Leads and participates in maintaining pump station, including daily inspections, periodic lubrication and adjustment, and emergency repairs as needed.
- Communicates with residents regarding sewer system work as it affects their properties and coordinate with other agencies as necessary.

Minimum Qualifications:

Any combination of experience and education may be considered. A typical way to obtain the knowledge, skills, and abilities would be a high school diploma or GED equivalent and at least four years of increasingly responsible experience in the cleaning, servicing, operation and maintenance of sewer systems with at least one year of experience in a supervisory or lead capacity.

Possession of a California Water Environment Association (CWEA) Collection System Maintenance 3 Certificate is required within nine months of appointment. Possession of a valid California Class B Driver's License with air brake and tanker endorsements is also required within six months of appointment is also required and must be maintained throughout employment with the City.

Benefits:

The City of San Gabriel offers a generous benefits package, which includes:

- Participation in the CalPERS Retirement System: 2% @ 60 for "classic" CalPERS members (which goes up to a maximum of 2.418% @ 63) and 2% @ 62 for new CalPERS members; participating San Gabriel employees will remain in their existing tier.
- Cafeteria plan which includes a choice of multiple PPO and HMO medical plans (the City contracts with CalPERS for health insurance), two dental plans, and vision plan.
- **Other Benefits:**
 - \$100 per month for Bilingual Pay for second language proficiency in Cantonese, Mandarin, Vietnamese, or Spanish.
 - A \$200 work shoe/boot safety allowance
 - Choice of enrollment in multiple Deferred Compensation (457) Programs
 - Optional enrollment in Supplemental Insurance Programs
 - City-paid long term disability and life insurance (1x annual salary)
 - City-paid Employee Assistance Program (EAP) and Travel Assistance Program for employees and eligible family members
 - Payment of retiree (and family) health insurance per established vesting schedule
- **Leaves:**
 - 12 days of sick leave per calendar year
 - 10 days of vacation per year
 - 11 holidays per year, plus 1 floating holiday
- **Cash Outs:**
 - Sick Leave Buy Back Program allows cash out of 50% of unused sick leave accrued in the 12 month period between November and October.
 - Holiday Buy Back Program allows a maximum of 8 hours of unused vacation to be paid back to the employee during the second pay period of the calendar year.
