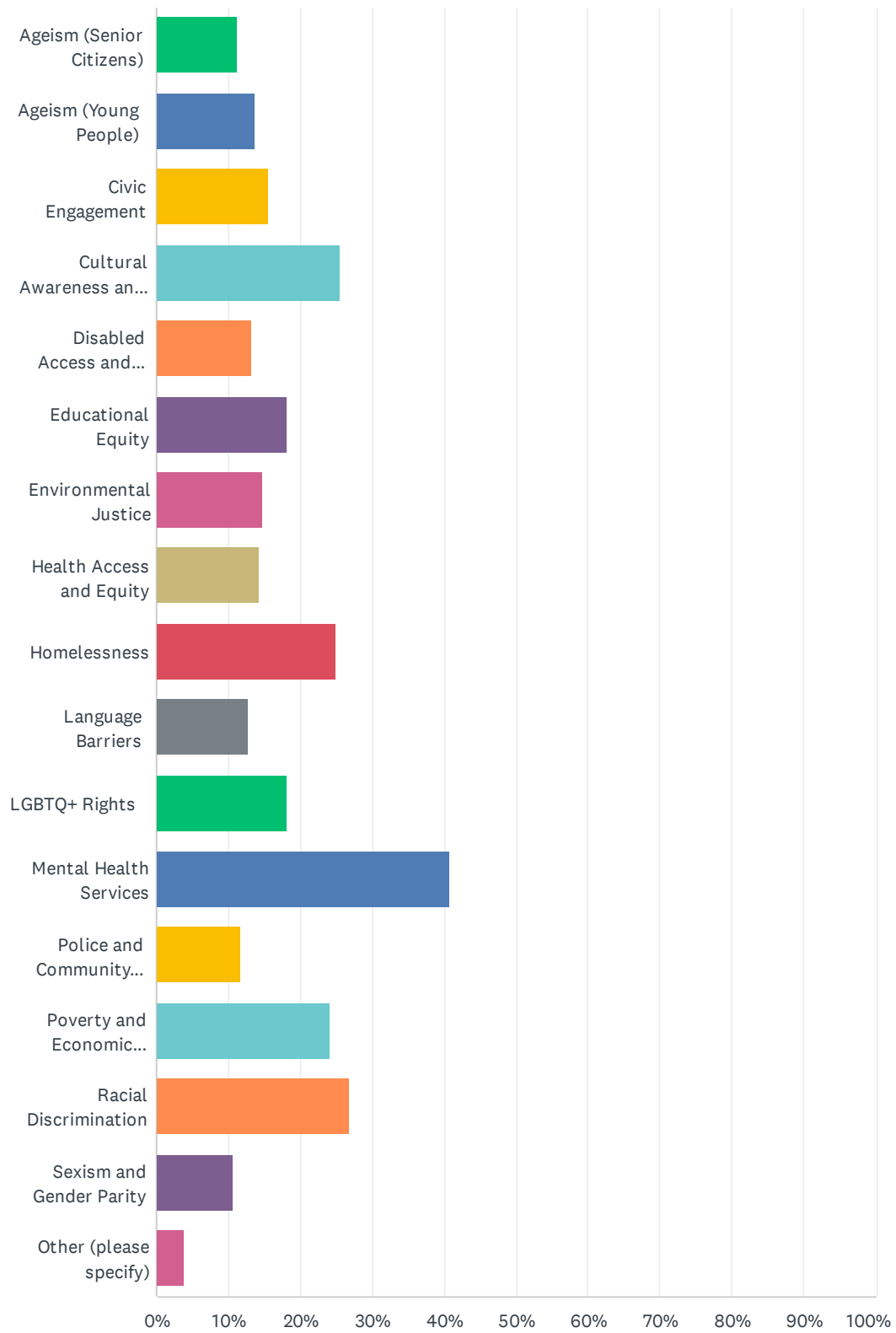

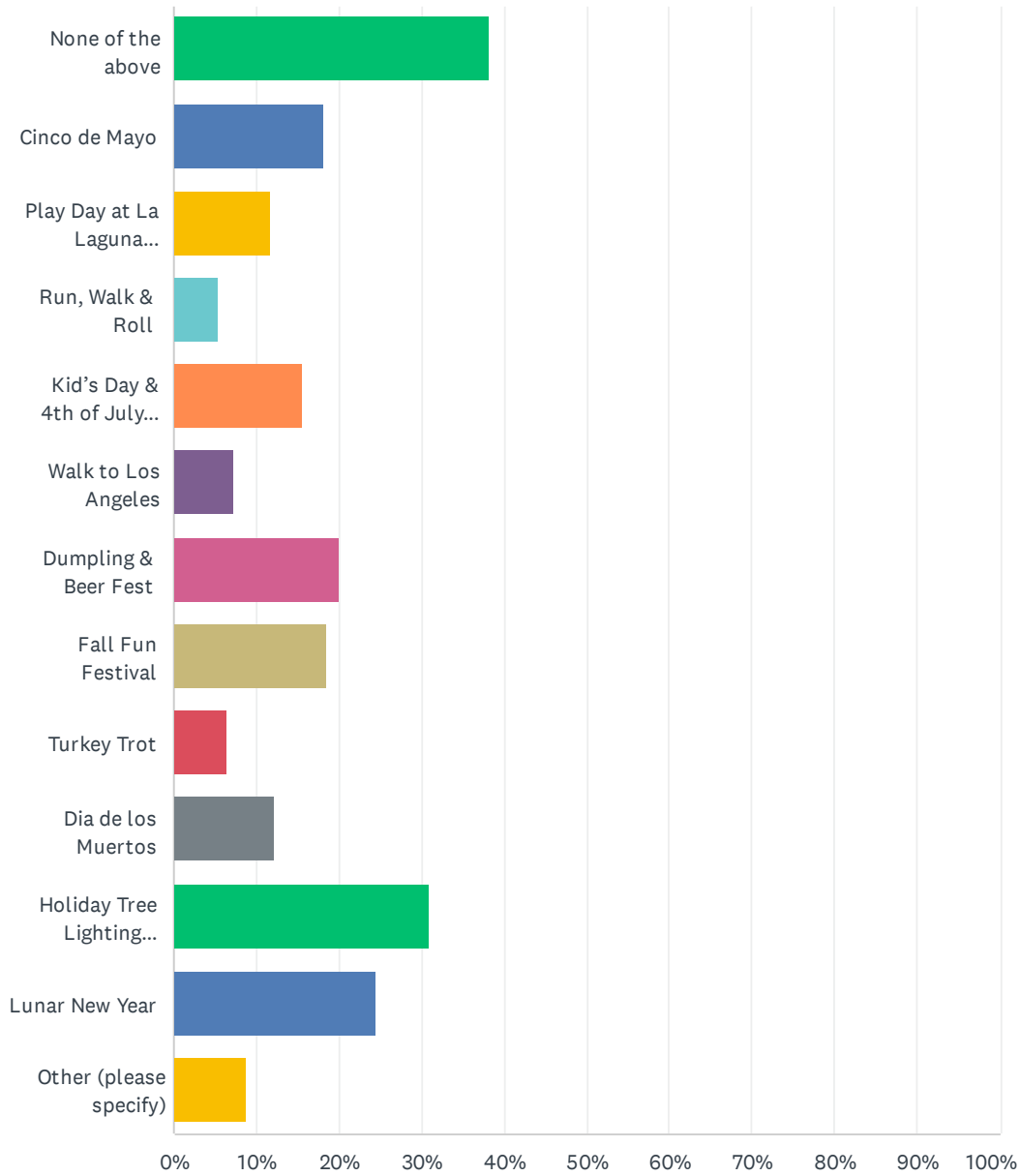

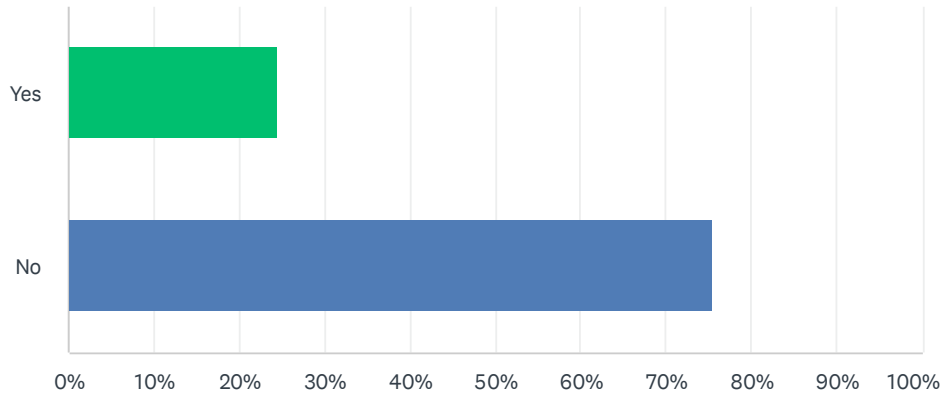

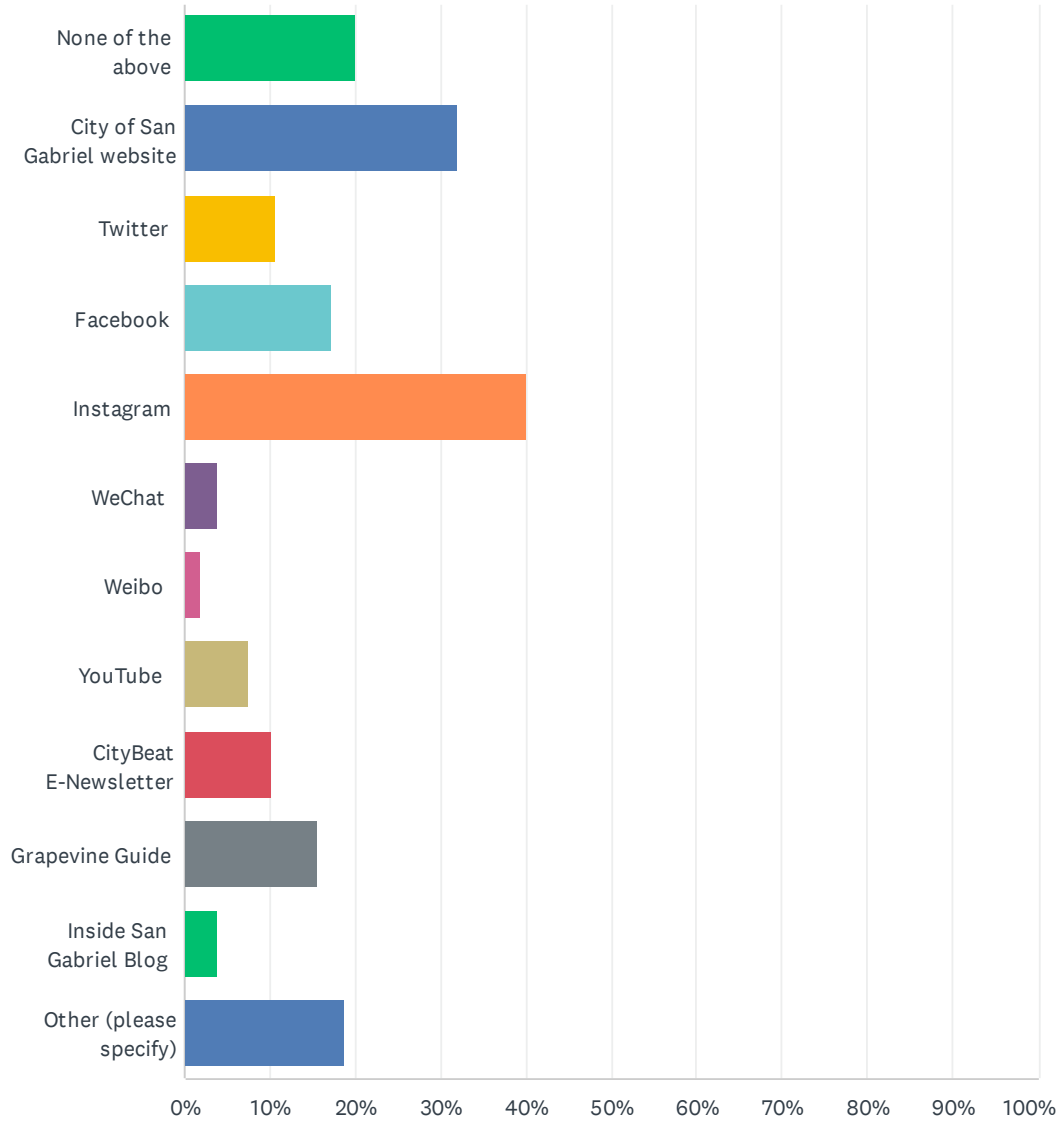

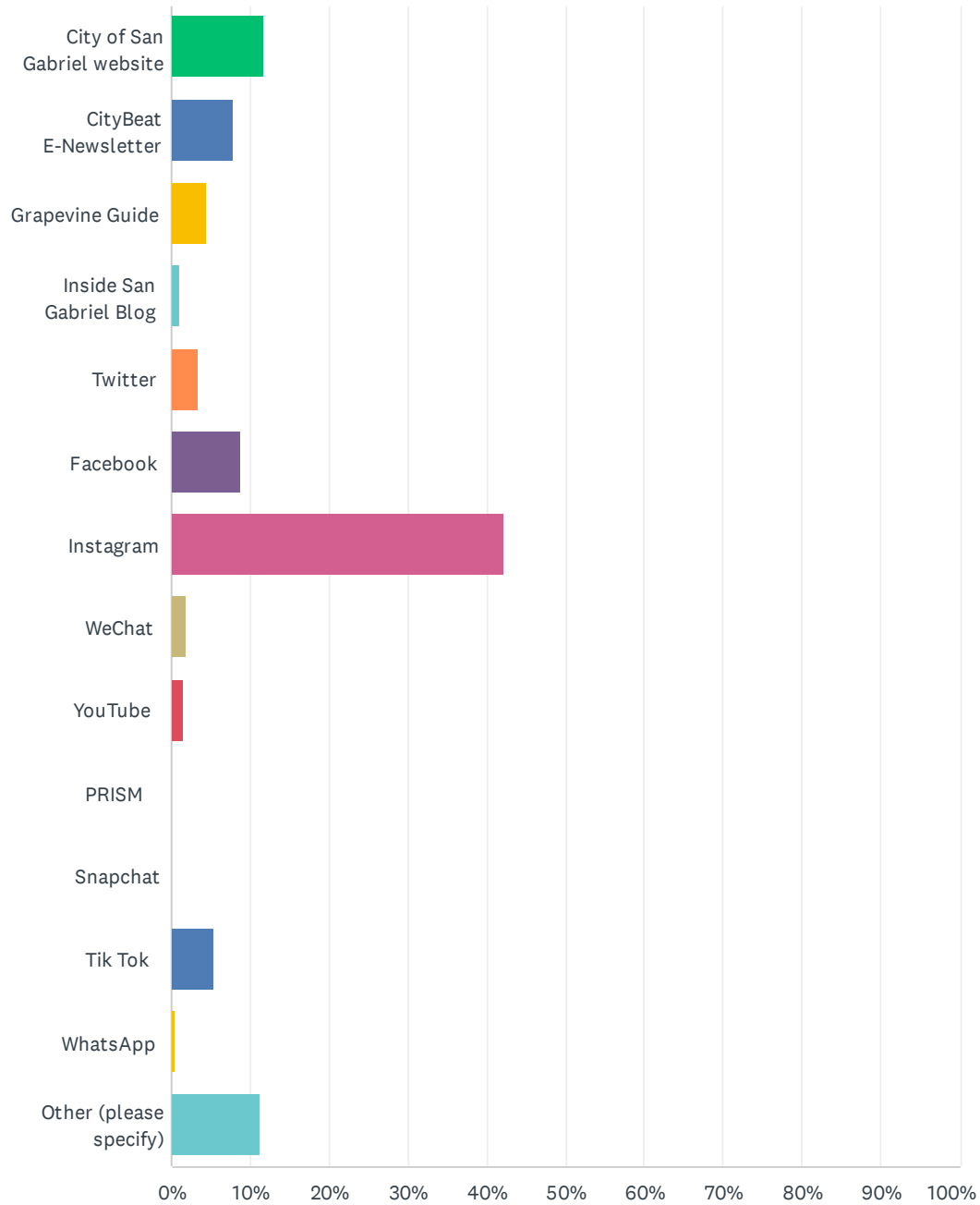

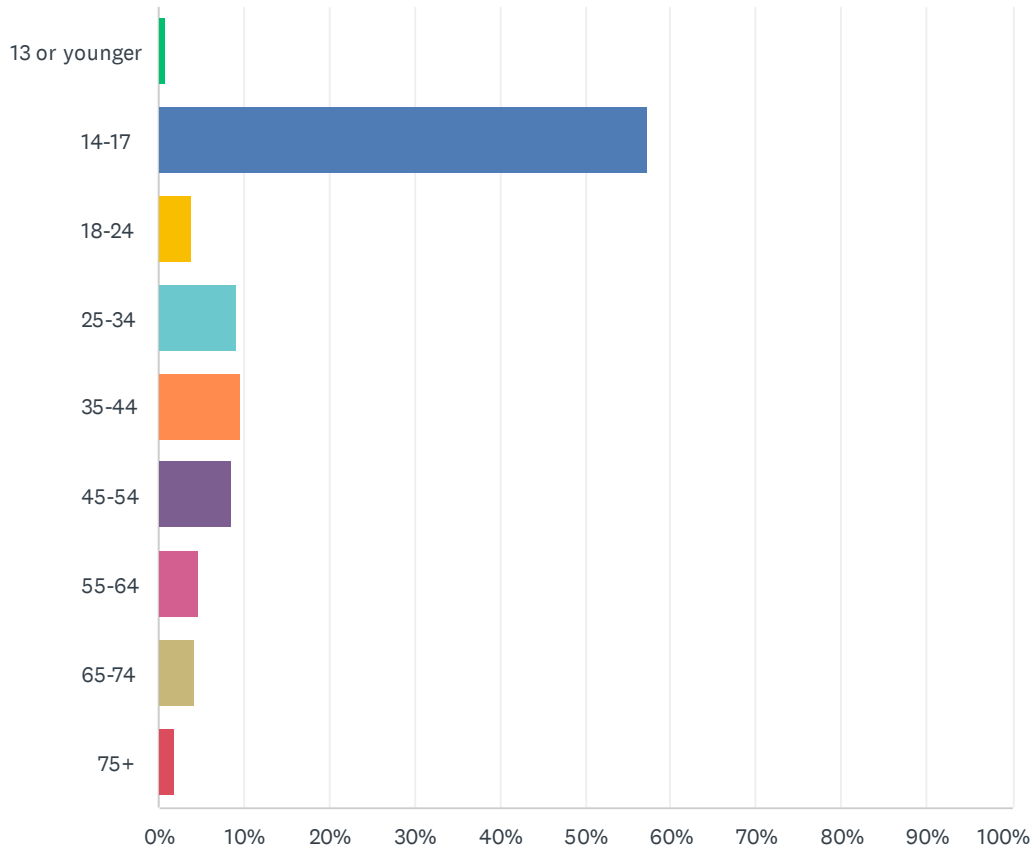

Q10 What is your age-range?

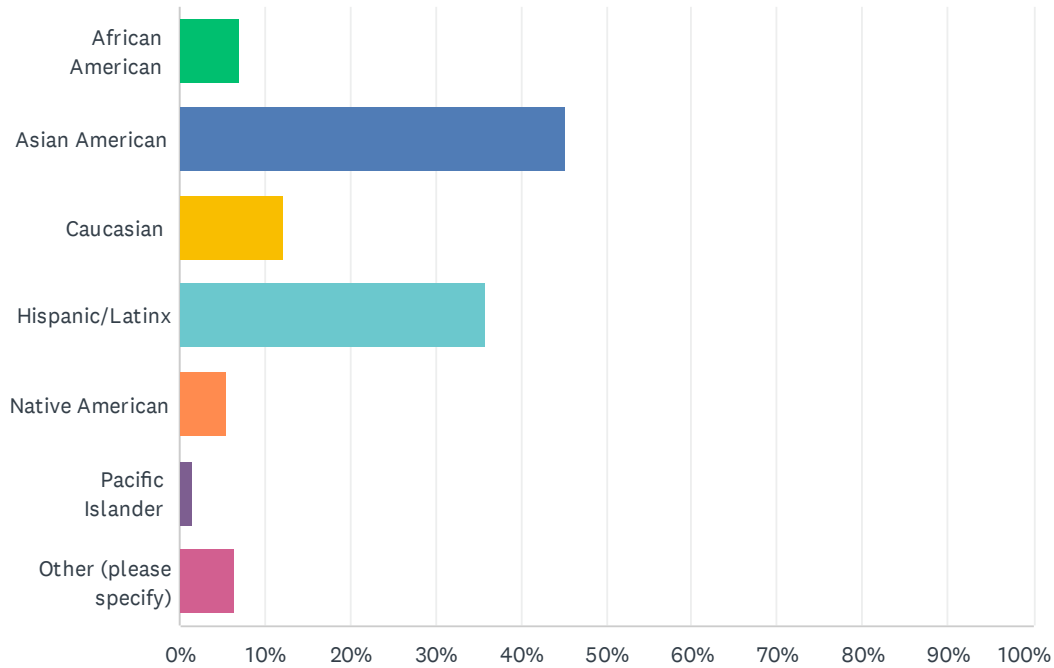

Q11 What is your ethnicity? Please check all that apply:

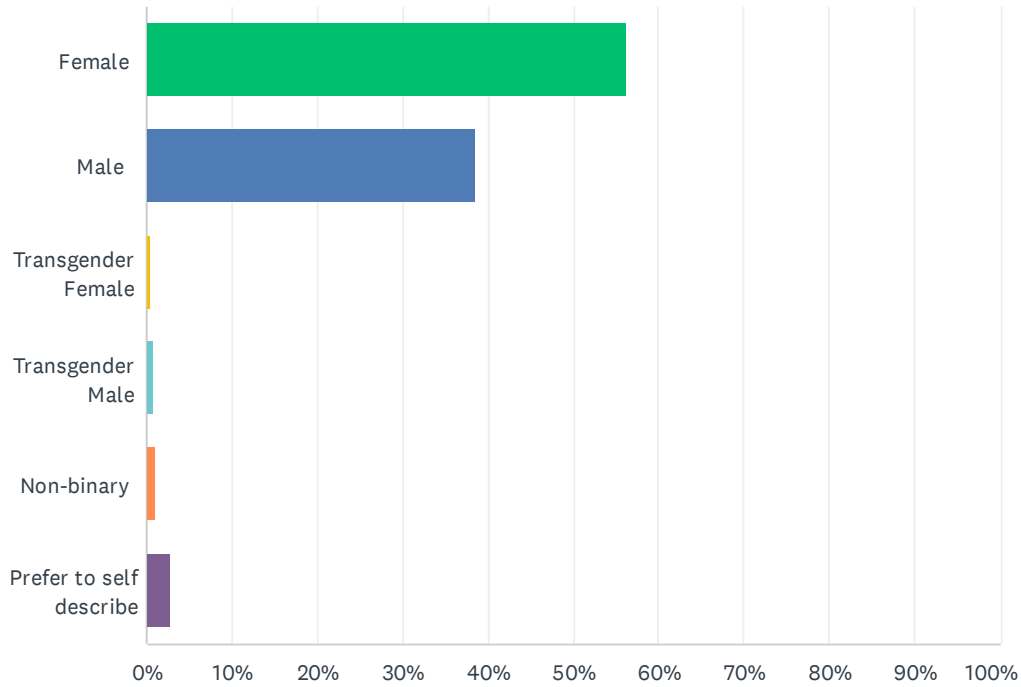
