The Opportunity:

The City of San Gabriel's Community Services Department is seeking an energetic individual with the ability to work effectively within a diverse community. The ideal candidate can plan, supervise, lead, and direct youths in a wide variety of recreational activities. This individual will provide quality program supervision with an emphasis on meeting the recreational needs of youth in the community.

Position Summary:

Under general supervision of the Recreation Supervisor, the Recreation Leader has the primary responsibility for planning, developing, conducting, and supervising a wide variety of activities for children including homework assistance, sports, games, recreation activities, and special events. The Recreation Leader will also teach the basic fundamentals of play and sportsmanship in organized team activities. The Recreation Leader will be responsible for assisting in program publicity through the use of flyers, newsletters, signs, and posters; keeping records and prepare related reports; adhering to City and departmental policies and procedures; and other related work as assigned. **This position involves a varying schedule and requires working nights, weekends and holidays as needed.**

Minimum Qualifications:

Any equivalent combination of training experience that provides the required knowledge skills and abilities could be considered. Must possess basic skills, and knowledge of methods, practices, and equipment used in maintaining an effective recreational program. Must have the ability to organize, conduct, and supervise recreational activities, as well as establish and maintain effective working relationships with staff members, volunteers, and the general public. The ideal candidate also must be able to complete certification in CPR and First Aid within 3-months of hire.

PARS Requirement:

Part-Time Employees are required to participate in the Public Retirement Services (PARS) in lieu of Social Security.

Bilingual Pay: Bilingual pay of \$.58 per hour is available to employees who qualify and pass a proficiency examination in a second language such as Cantonese, Mandarin, Vietnamese, or Spanish.
