PLANNING COMMISSION *(Two-year term)*

The Planning Commission is established by State Government Code 65100 and its organization is provided by San Gabriel Municipal Code Section § 33.30, and is composed of five members who must be residents. The Commission reviews the development and beautification of the City in respect to its private buildings, streets, and vacant lots; and recommends to the City Council that proposed plans are consistent with the future growth and development of the City in order to secure its inhabitants through adequate sanitation services and public infrastructure. The Planning Commission is also responsible for directing future growth in the City and implementing the City's General Plan.
